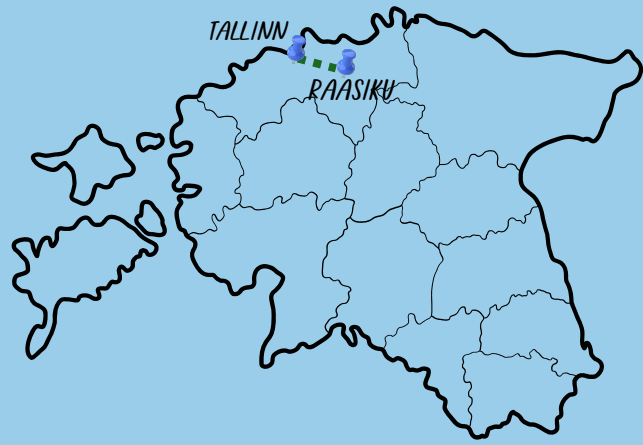

RAASIKU PARISH AND VILLAGE



Raasiku parish is located in southeast of Estonia, in Harju county. It has a **population of 5352 people** (registered by June 2025).

Raasiku village is the second largest village in the parish. Life in Raasiku is rooted in **community values** and local pride, like village festivals where residents **celebrate their heritage** with music, food, handicrafts, and dancing. Estonia is famous for its choral traditions, and Raasiku supports this through **local choirs and musical groups**. Many locals also value knitting, woodworking, and other traditional skills—often passed down for generations.

Raasiku is **ideal for nature lovers**. The area is mostly flat, with lush forests, fields, and bog landscapes nearby. You'll find **hiking paths and forest trails**, **birdwatching** opportunities, a peaceful **river and wetlands**. The natural environment plays an important role in local life, with **foraging** (mushroom and berry picking) being a beloved seasonal activity.

HOSTING ORGANIZATION WILL ASSURE...

1. CLEAR INFORMATION AND EXPECTATIONS

We strive to provide detailed information about the volunteer's tasks, daily schedule, rules, and what is expected from them.

2. WARM AND SUPPORTIVE WORK ENVIRONMENT

We will create a welcoming atmosphere where the volunteer feels included, supported, and appreciated by staff and students.

3. ORIENTATION AND TASK TRAINING

We offer an introduction to the work environment and task training.

4. ONGOING SUPERVISION AND MENTORSHIP

We will assign a contact person or mentor who regularly checks in, offers guidance, and answers questions.

5. OPPORTUNITIES TO SHARE THEIR CULTURE

We encourage and support the volunteer in creating cultural activities and presentations for the children or community.

6. CLEAR COMMUNICATION

We maintain open and respectful communication with the volunteer and the coordinating organization.

7. RESPECT FOR THE VOLUNTEER'S WELLBEING AND BOUNDARIES

We ensure the volunteer has reasonable working hours, breaks, and is not given responsibilities beyond their role.

8. RECOGNITION AND INCLUSION

We involve the volunteer in school or kindergarten activities and acknowledge their contributions publicly when appropriate.

9. SAFE ENVIRONMENT

We ensure that the setting is safe for both children and volunteers.

10. FEEDBACK AND REFLECTION OPPORTUNITIES

We provide space for the volunteer to share feedback, reflect on their experience, and grow personally and professionally.

THE COORDINATING ORGANIZATION

Eesti Erinoorsootöö Ühing **noOR** (Erinoor) is a **coordinating organisation** based in Estonia that **supports foreign volunteers** participating in the **European Solidarity Corps (ESC)**. They **connect volunteers with local kindergartens, schools, and social institutions**, where volunteers assist with daily activities and cultural exchange.

MTÜ noOR takes care of the **practical, administrative, and personal support** for each volunteer. This includes arranging accommodation, providing food and pocket money, organizing transportation, and offering mentorship and training throughout the volunteering period. Their **goal is to help you grow, explore, and feel at home while making a meaningful contribution to the local community.**

Here's what they do for you:

-  Help arrange your **accommodation, food allowance, and pocket money**
-  Organise your **local transport to and from your project**
-  Provide **orientation and training** at the start and during your stay
-  **Connect** you with your **hosting organisation** (like a school or kindergarten)
-  Offer **ongoing support and guidance** throughout your volunteering
-  Be **someone you can turn to** if you have questions, ideas, or challenges
-  **Support your learning** and help you complete your **Youthpass certificate**
